Frequently Asked Questions	Response
What ages are eligible to participate?	Students in grades PK-2 may participate.
When do practices begin?	We will have an open gym for all registered participants on Saturday, Dec. 10. Practices will begin on Tuesday, Jan 3.
When does play start for the league?	The season begins Jan. 7 and runs until Feb. 25.
Are there teams for both boys and girls?	We play co-ed for our PK/K team - the 1st and 2nd grade teams allow gender specific play.
What teams are offered?	PK/K 1st/2nd
Will there be a parents meeting before the season begins?	Yes. PK/K parents will meet on Dec. 10 at 9:30 and 1st/2nd parents will meet on Dec. 10 at 10:30 in the Alumni Gym.
How do I register for YMCA?	You may register online by clicking here .
Is there an “A” and a “B” league?	No, there is not an “A” or a “B” track.
Will my child be guaranteed playing time?	Yes - Y rules mandate substitutions and play time.
What does the game schedule look like?	You should expect to begin play in early January - league play continues until mid-February.
How many games a week should we expect?	1 game per week
What days are games played?	Saturday - there are no games scheduled during the week.
What times are games?	Games are usually played prior to 12p.
Where are games played?	CDS Alumni Gym, Reuter YMCA, Woodfin Elementary.
How many days a week do teams practice?	1x per week.

What times are practices?	Practice time is from 330-@415p.
Where are practices?	Practices take place at the Reuter YMCA.
How does my child get to Reuter?	We'll shuttle kids to the YMCA via CDS bus.
Where do I pick-up my child?	You may pick-up your child at Reuter or at CDS - our shuttle will return to CDS.
Who coaches?	Teams are coached by parent volunteers. Coaches are "coached" by CDS YMCA administrators.
